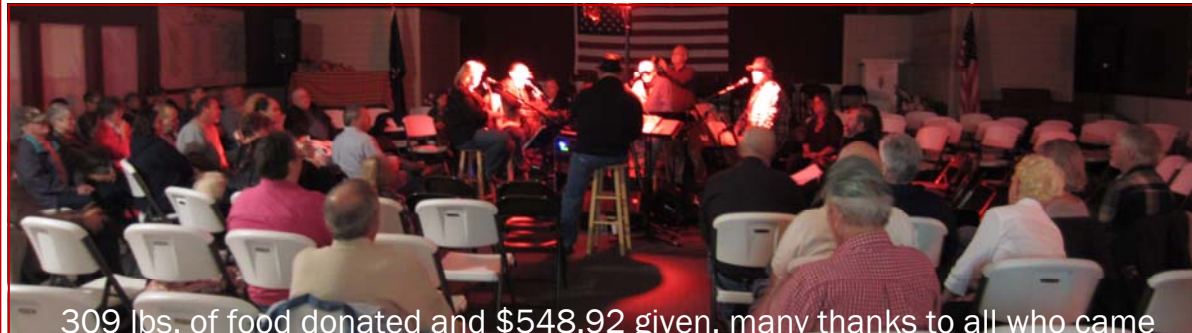

AN EVENING WITH CIRCLE OF FRIENDS






