## SEWING KINDNESS

Thanks to the participants of the PLUS unit at Wabash Valley Correctional Facility for donating twenty quilts to Grace Center! The quilts donated are being used to raise money to purchase food for the Food Pantry which serves approximately twenty families per week in the Clear Creek, Indian Creek and Polk townships in southern Monroe County. The quilts are available for a donation of \$40.00 or more while supplies last. The PLUS program, "Purposeful Living Units Serve", is a faith-and-character-based initiative of the Indiana Department of Correction, started in 2005. The long-term goal of the program is helping prepare offenders to re-enter society by equipping them with spiritual, moral and character development skills



as well as life skills. As part of the offenders' service, they have learned to make quilts that are then given to those in need, to not-for-profits for fund-raising, or given to parents of Indiana service men and women who have been killed in the line of duty. Thanks again to all the participants at PLUS of Wabash Valley for their kindness and for the time spent making the wonderful quilts.

## PUMPKIN SQUARES

| 2 cups flour    | 2 tsp. baking powder |
| 1 tsp. salt     | 1 tsp. soda          |
| 2 tsp. cinnamon | 2 cups sugar         |

Mix the above ingredients then add the following:

Blend well and pour into a large greased cookie sheet.

Bake in a 375 degree oven 30-35 minutes or until done.

1 to 2 tablespoons heavy cream


